Registration form must be completed accurately and in full. Missing information and documentation will delay the registration process as your registration will be returned to you. Uniforms will only be issued to players who are fully registered. Please read the following carefully to ensure that all required items are enclosed.

1. Fully completed and signed registration form.
2. Registration fee, either by cheque payable to SUSC dated current, or by completing the VISA or MasterCard information below.
3. Uniform deposit of \$100, post-dated to April 1, 2011 (which is destroyed when uniform is returned in good condition).
4. Players born in 2000 (U-11) – must submit a photocopy of their birth certificate and a passport-size colour photo (1 ½" x 1 ½").
5. Players born in 1997 (U-14) and 1995 (U-16) – must submit a new, updated color photo.
6. All new players to Surrey United - must submit color photo and photocopy of birth certificate.

REGISTRATION & CLUB FACTS

All formal communication from parents to the club coaches, executive, administrative and technical staff must be submitted via their designated team manager in written format (emails are not considered to be formal communication).

- 1) All formal communication from parents to the club coaches, executive, administrative and technical staff must be submitted via their designated team manager in written format (emails are not considered to be formal communication).
- 2) Parents/guardians of registered players of the Surrey United Soccer Club must abide by the parent code of conduct. This can be obtained from the designated team manager or from the official website www.surreyunitedsoccer.com.
- 3) Practice times and days are determined by the Executive and will be posted at the start of the season. The registrars do not have information on where and when each team will practice. Select teams train a minimum of two sessions per week (not including games).
- 4) Any player wishing to play up an age group must obtain approval from the club Technical Director.
- 5) The regular season runs from September to March with a break from late December to early January. Cup play may extend into April & May. If applicable, Provincial Cup competitions are typically held in July.
- 6) Games are typically played Saturdays (boys) and/or Sundays (girls)
- 7) The "select" and intermediate teams will be selected using a combination of formal tryouts and ongoing evaluations.
- 8) Players are expected to commit to all training sessions and games associated with their team.
- 9) Recreational program - All efforts are made to place children from the same school/neighbourhood on the same team. This is NOT always possible.
- 10) Specific requests will be considered but NOT guaranteed.
