

VISITORS GAME DAY GUIDE: RETURN TO PLAY



PRE-GAME

- Review our [Return to Play Plan](#) and communicate it with your players and their families
- **All teams visiting from outside of the City of Surrey must ensure they keep the roster information for the players participating in the match including their first name, last name, and email address or phone number for at least 30 days following the match.** This is a City of Surrey Contact Tracing requirement and the City and/or the Health Authorities may contact you for this information
- Identify time and location of game and plan a meeting location with your team using Surrey United's [Return to Play Park Maps](#)
- Spectators:
 - Must respect social distancing requirements
 - Must complete a COVID-19 symptom check and remain home if there are any signs of illness
 - Must adhere to all requirements of our [Return to Play Plan](#)
 - Are not permitted on the playing surface at any time
- Visiting Players must:
 - Review and complete the Surrey United Return to Play [Checklist](#) before heading to the field
 - Adhere to all requirements of the Surrey United [Return to Play Plan](#)
- Visiting Team Staff must:
 - Review and complete the Surrey United [Pre-Session Checklist](#)
 - Follow and prepare fully for any additional Return to Play requirements of the home team, if any
 - Adhere to all requirements of the Surrey United [Return to Play Plan](#)

POST-GAME

- No cool down (including removal of cleats, shin pads, etc.) permitted on the field or within the end zones of the field. Please exit the field immediately after the match ends to allow for transition to the next game without risk of additional or unnecessary gathering
