Updated Health Order Information

BC Soccer has provided us with a quick reference tool for understanding who requires evidence of double vaccination following the October 25, 2021 Provincial Health Order. The implementation of these requirements is not a reflection of the Board of Directors or the Club's Operations Staff and our compliance is not optional.

We understand this is personal to many members and their families, as well as to Club staff, so we ask all members to remember to approach the topic with care and consideration of the personal nature of this requirement that has been placed on us all and to respect the unusual position the Club and its volunteers have been placed in.

The chart below summarizes the requirement for proof of vaccination:
