Basic details of the program include:

You may choose to pay the fee and opt-out of completing any volunteer hours

Volunteer hours can be fulfilled between July 1st and June 30th of the calendar year

Volunteer hours are managed centrally by the Club's Volunteer Coordinator and there is a process in place for scheduling and recording of these volunteer hours
